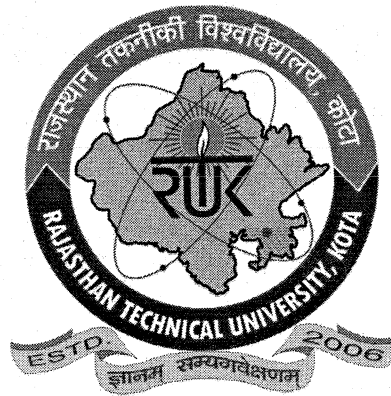

AC 39.4 To consider and pass the grace for conferment of degrees in XIII Convocation 2024 to students passed out in examination year 2022 and 2023 or before, for UG, PG and Ph. D. Programme.

Students who have passed their B. Tech., B. Arch., BHMCT, BBA, MBA, MCA, M. Tech., M. Arch. and Ph.D. course in examination year 2022 & 2023 (two pass-out batches) and get subsequent result on or before 30th April, 2024 may be considered for passing the grace for conferment of degrees in 13th Convocation- 2024. For Ph. D. course, members are requested to consider the last date of eligibility as date of Academic Council meeting.

Therefore, the Council is requested to pass the grace for conferment of degree to pass-out students of B. Tech., B. Arch., BHMCT, BBA, MBA, MCA, M. Tech. and M. Arch. course in the examination year 2022 & 2023 (two pass-out batches) and cleared their eligibility on or before 30th April, 2024 and for Ph. D. students, as date of Academic Council meeting and also to record date of conferment of degree/Gold Medals as per Convocation Ordinance No. 10. (Annexure 39.4 Page No. 13)

Further, Council is also requested to authorize Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor to include such other students afterwards who have completed their degrees up to 30th April, 2024 but their names could not include in the Degree Register at present.

AC 39.5 To consider and approve the Chancellor's and Vice-Chancellor's Gold Medal at the 13th Convocation of the University.

Hon'ble Chancellor has directed vide its letter no. DO no. F1(39)RB/2016:7927 dated 28.09.2016 to institute Chancellor's Gold Medal to the topper of post- graduation course in any one stream. This medal shall be awarded each year by rotation system.



In view of Raj Bhawan direction, the compliance report was submitted vide RTU letter no. RTU/VCS/F(1)5/2016 dated 29.11.2016 and roster of rotation was also communicated.

The matter was placed before Academic Council at its 24th meeting vide agenda item no. 24.3 and approved the roaster of rotation of Chancellor's Gold Medal and also decided the institution of Vice-Chancellor's Gold Medal to highest topper of B. Tech. course.

This year Chancellor's Gold Medal will be awarded to overall topper of P.G. Programme in Master of Business Administration i.e. MBA for the 2022 pass-out batch and Master of Computer Application i.e. MCA for the 2023 pass-out pass-out batch respectively, who were admitted in batch 2020-21 and 2021-22 respectively and have completed their degree/passed out on or before 30th April, 2024.

AC 39.7 To consider and approve the format of B. TECH. (HONOURS) Degree of CBCS Scheme students.

The CBCS scheme was implemented from the session 2018-19 for B. Tech. course. As per the CBCS guidelines, "a student will be eligible to get B. Tech. (Honours) Degree, if he/she completed an additional 20 credits through MOOCs only." Many students have completed the minimum requirements of B. Tech. (Honours) Degree. Accordingly, mark sheets and provisional certificates have been issued. B. Tech. (Honours) Degree is to be conferred to such students in forthcoming XIII Convocation-2024 for the first time. Therefore, the format of B. Tech. (Honours) Degree is submitted for consideration before the Hon'ble members. (Annexure 39.7 Page No. 34-47)

AC 39.8 To consider an additional mercy chance/mercy chance to the students of B. Tech, B. Arch., BHMCT, BBA, MCA, MBA, M. Tech. and M. Arch. who have not completed their degree even after completion of double the duration of prescribed course time/permitted course duration.

1. As per University rules, a student admitted in B. Tech, B. Tech. (LEEP), BHMCT, B. Arch., BBA, MCA, MCA (Lateral Entry), MBA, M. Tech. & M. Arch. course is required to complete his/her course/degree in 8, 7, 8, 10, 6, 6, 5, 4, 4 & 4 years duration respectively i.e. double the duration prescribed for the course.
2. Previously, as per decision of Academic council and BOM, the students of B. Tech. 2006 to 2014 (LEEP 2007 to 2015), BHMCT 2006 to 2014, B. Arch. 2006 to 2012, BBA 2013 to 2016, MCA 2006 to 2016, MBA 2006 to 2018, M. Tech. & M. Arch. 2006 to 2018 admitted batches were given mercy chances and additional mercy chances who could not pass all papers and did not complete

their degree within the stipulated/permitted period. (Orders are enclosed)

3. Many requests, representations and letters are continuously receiving from the students, Hon'ble Rajbhawan, Technical Education Department and other Departments of State Govt. to grant an additional mercy/mercy chance to students who have not completed their degree due to back papers after completion permitted/stipulated time period prescribed for the course.
4. The matter of granting mercy/additional mercy chance was placed before the Exam Committee in its meeting held on dated 24.04.2024 vide agenda item no. 02. The committee recommends to grant mercy chance/additional mercy chance to due batches of all courses from the session 2006-07.
5. In this context following agenda is proposed for consideration of Academic Council:-
 - (i) Granting of **an additional mercy chance** to students of B. Tech. 2006 to 2014 (LEEP-2007 to 2015), BHMCT 2006 to 2014, B. Arch. 2006 to 2012, BBA 2006 to 2016, MCA 2006 to 2016, (MCA- Lateral Entry 2007 to 2017), MBA 2006 to 2018, M. Tech. 2006 to 2018 & M. Arch. 2006 to 2018 admitted batches in the academic session 2023-24. The same exam may be conducted separately as Examination 2023-24.
 - (ii) Granting of **a mercy chance** to students of B. Tech. 2015 (LEEP-2016), BHMCT 2015, B. Arch. 2013, BBA 2017, MCA 2017, (MCA- Lateral Entry 2018), MBA 2019, M. Tech. 2019 and M. Arch. 2019 admitted batches in the academic session 2023-24. The same exam may be conducted along with the additional mercy Examination 2023-24 as mentioned in point no. (i).
 - (iii) Granting of **a mercy chance** to students of B. Tech. 2016 (LEEP-2017), BHMCT 2016, B. Arch. 2014, BBA 2018, MCA 2018 (MCA- Lateral Entry 2019), MBA 2020, M. Tech. 2020 & M. Arch. 2020 admitted batches in the academic session 2024-25 along with the regular batches examination.

Members are requested to kindly consider and approve granting an additional mercy chance/mercy chance to above mentioned batches students. (Annexure 39.8 Page No. 48-53)

AC 39.12 It is proposed that there should be prescribed minimum passing marks in the end semester examination for all theory subjects. It is proposed that twenty five percent (25%) of the total marks in the end semester exam must be attained by the student to pass that subject.

1. To maintain the quality and standard of academic evaluation, a student should score bare minimum passing marks in the end semester exams only. This was already in practice previously.
2. The sanctity of end semester exam conducted by RTU under proper scrutiny is much more trustworthy compared to the internal exams conducted by affiliated colleges.
3. The weightage of internal marks may also be reduced to 20% as previously implemented by RTU.

Resolution : Referred back to Dean, Faculty Affairs due to lack of due process.

विषय: एम.टेक.-टेक्सटाइल टेक्नोलॉजी (टेक्नीकल टेक्सटाइल) प्रोग्राम प्रारंभ करने के संबंध में।

महोदय,

उपरोक्त विषयान्तर्गत निवेदन है कि :-

- 1 कॉलेज में संचालित एम टेक (टेक्सटाइल टेक्नोलॉजी) पाठ्यक्रम सत्र 2011-12 से संचालित किया जा रहा है। हाल ही वस्त्र मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार द्वारा देश में टेक्नीकल टेक्सटाइल को बढ़ावा देने के उद्देश्य से इस क्षेत्र में नये पाठ्यक्रम चालू करने हेतु जारी नेशनल टेक्नीकल टेक्सटाइल मिशन (NTTM) योजना के तहत वित्तीय सहायता प्रदान करने के लिये आवेदन आमंत्रित किये थे। इस कॉलेज ने भी आवेदन किया था जिसके परिणाम स्वरूप कॉलेज को रु 205 लाख की वित्तीय सहायता स्वीकृत की गई है। (प्रति संलग्न-1)
- 2 योजना में आवेदन के समय अंकित कॉलेज की प्रतिबद्धताओं के तहत वर्तमान में संचालित एम टेक (टेक्सटाइल टेक्नोलॉजी) पाठ्यक्रम को ही नये स्वरूप में एम. टेक. टेक्सटाइल टेक्नोलॉजी (टेक्नीकल टेक्सटाइल) नाम से प्रारंभ करना प्रस्तावित किया गया।
- 3 इस हेतु आवश्यक राजस्थान सरकार से भी अनापत्ति प्रमाण पत्र जारी करने हेतु आवेदन गया था। राज्य सरकार की ओर से अनापत्ति पत्र अभी तक अपेक्षित है। हालांकि अखिल भारतीय तकनीकी शिक्षा परिषद (अभातशिप), नई दिल्ली ने रसीद को स्वीकार कर लिया गया। (रसीद की छाया प्रति संलग्न-2)
- 4 उक्त पाठ्यक्रम को प्रारंभ करने हेतु अभातशिप, नई दिल्ली से अनुमोदन प्राप्त करने हेतु आवेदन करते समय माननीय कुलपति, राजस्थान तकनीकी विश्वविद्यालय, कोटा (प्रबंध मंडल के अध्यक्ष के रूप में) से प्रशासनिक स्वीकृति पत्रावली पर प्राप्त कर ली गई थी। (नोटशीट की छायाप्रति संलग्न-3)
- 5 अभातशिप की स्कूटनी कमिटी ने अनुमोदन की अनुशंषा कर दी है। (अनुशंषा की प्रति संलग्न-4)
- 6 पाठ्यक्रम का नाम परिवर्तन करने हेतु आवश्यक निर्धारित शुल्क रूपये 59000/- (उनसठ हजार मात्र) URN No. 406211161126 PRN No. 406211143979 कॉलेज द्वारा रा.त.वि. के खाते में जमा करा दिया गया है। (कार्यालय आदेश की छायाप्रति संलग्न-5)

उपरोक्त तथ्यों के आधार पर प्रस्तावित पाठ्यक्रम के सिलेबस में आवश्यक संशोधन किया जाना है। टेक्सटाइल विषयों में केवल इसी कॉलेज में प्रोग्राम संचालित किये जाते हैं।





Annexure II: Terms and conditions

(c) If, as the result of Force Majeure event, the institute is unable to perform its obligations.

22.
